I was dispatched to 3785 E Gemini Drive in Alexandria, Madison County in reference to a eighteen year old being force into a silver vehicle. Dispatch then advised that the female subject was being pinned to the ground by her father.

When I arrived I noticed a white female later identified as Suzan L. Hardin walking towards my patrol vehicle. As I stepped out of my patrol vehicle I observed a white male later identified as Jeffrey Lee Hardin setting on the legs of a white female later identified as [REDACTED] Hardin and holding her down by her shoulders with his hands at which time [REDACTED] was screaming help and get off of me. Mrs. Hardin stated that she was a police officer and that they had been looking for their daughter for three days and that he was restraining her. I advised Mrs. Hardin that I would speak with her in a minute. I ordered Mr. Hardin to get off [REDACTED]. Mr. Hardin told me to speak with his wife. I advised Mr. Hardin again to get off [REDACTED] at which time Mr. Hardin stated that him and his wife were police officers. I approached Mr. Hardin and ordered him again to get off [REDACTED] and let her go, at which time I was about to grab Mr. Hardin and escort him off [REDACTED], when Mr. Hardin jumped up in an aggressive manner and pulled his left arm back as if he was about to strike me and told me to get away from him. At this time I advised Madison County Dispatch that I needed additional officer for assistant and that I had two police officers that were uncooperative. I stepped back from Mr. Hardin and pulled my X26 Taser and told Mr. Hardin if he came at me again in an aggressive manner I would deploy my Taser. Mr. Hardin stated again that he was a police officer. I advised Mr. Hardin that I did not care and that he needed to calm down and step away from his daughter. As Mr. Hardin step away from the passenger side door of the vehicle [REDACTED] jumped out of the vehicle and ran inside the residence. I advised Mr. Hardin several times to
