The Office of Ombudsman for Older Minnesotans serves as an impartial third party which assists in resolving complaints about nursing homes, long term care residential facilities, home care agencies, and hospitals. Issues can include safety, health care quality, patient rights, government benefits, or other disputes or concerns.

Power of Attorney

Written authorization for someone to handle property or financial matters for you.

Vulnerable Adult/Adult Protection Services

Minnesota law protects adults who are vulnerable to maltreatment. Vulnerable Adult/Adult Protection Services investigate alleged abuse, neglect, exploitation or abandonment. Suspected maltreatment should be reported to the common entry point, which is typically the county Department of Human Services.
