# The Breeze ends three-year run

fall on the floor. To the surprise of everyone, a perfect image of La Virgen Morena (the Dark Virgin) was on Juan Diego's cloak.

The Bishop ordered a small church constructed on the site designated by the Virgin. The Virgin appeared on Tepeyac, the site of an Aztec temple dedicated to Tonatzin (earth goddess, mother of the gods and protectress of humanity).

Juan Diego's cloak has been subjected to extensive analysis and experts have authenticated the fabric as dating to the 16th century. It is doubtful that in the Colonial era in Mexico, human hands were capable of creating such an exquisite portrait. After 465 years, the image of the Virgen de Guadalupe, remains imprinted on the cloak.
