His favorite hobby is playing golf.

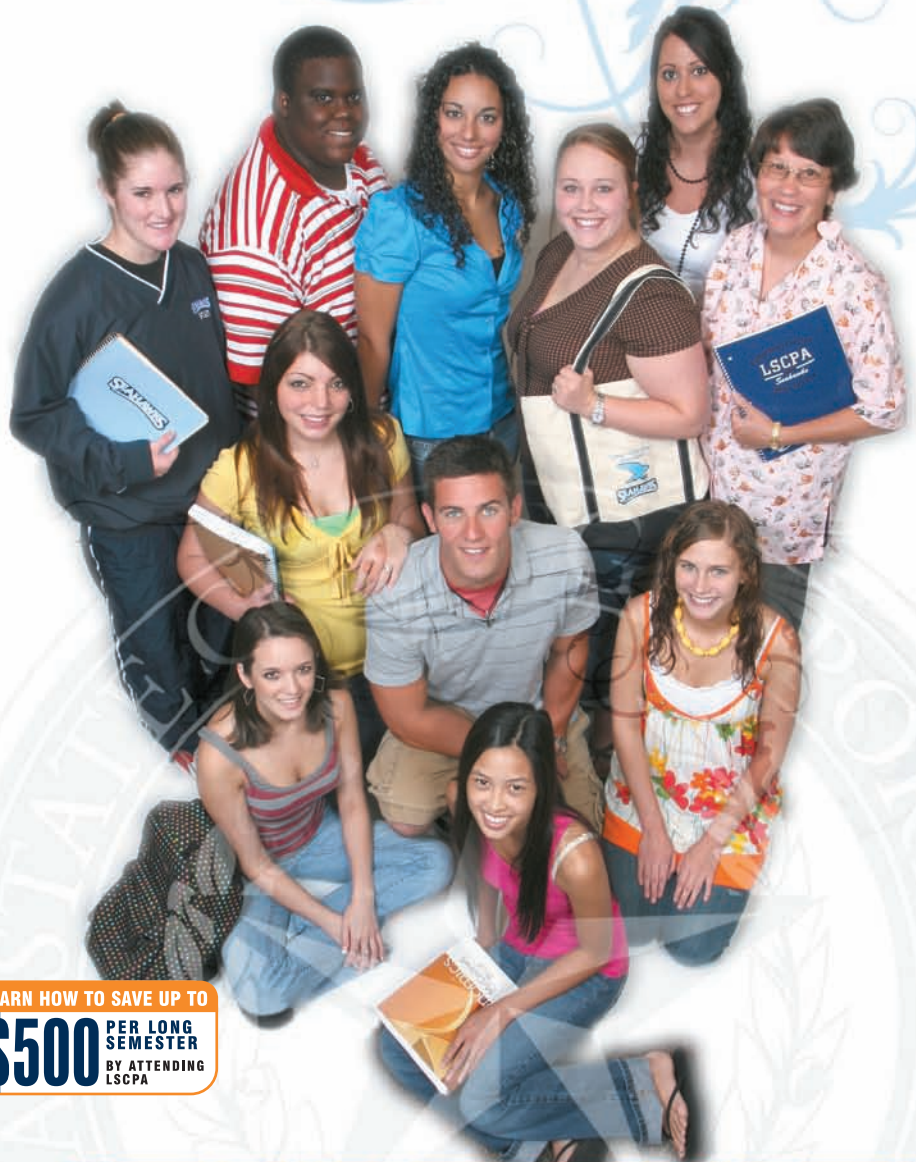
