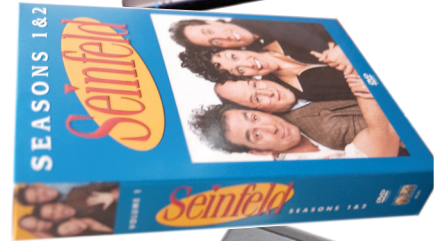
6 LAPTOP
