FIREPROOF (PG):

If you want to see a movie that will tug at your heart and could possibly change your life and marriage, you simply must see this God-respecting, Christ-honoring, marriage-building movie. Capt. Caleb Holt (Kirk Cameron) and his wife, Catherine (Erin Bethea) have drifted so far apart they are ready to leave each other. As a last ditch effort, Caleb's dad talks him into taking "The Love Dare" to save his marriage.

The film contains humor (pay close attention to the next door neighbors), and a few breath-holding rescues (they are firemen after all), but mostly it contains a simple "do the right thing" message. If you allow it to happen, you can't help but be blessed by this film. Also, if your relationship with your spouse or significant other is not where it needs to be, the cost of this film, and your commitment to actually watch it, should replace many hours in front of a marriage counselor.

BEDTIME STORIES (PG):

As the title implies, "Bedtime Stories" is just that. Working as a hotel janitor of sorts, Skeeter Bronson (Adam Sandler), winds up caring for his niece and nephew while his sister, Wendy (Courtney Cox), leaves town for a job interview. During this time, he wins over the kids with his unique style of bedtime stories, which begin to become true in real life. Seeing a golden opportunity, Skeeter then begins to maneuver the stories in a direction that will make his dreams come true.

As with most films these days, there are a few scenes that may be slightly objectionable, but there is not one curse word in the film. That alone is reason to watch and feel good about it.

PAUL BLART: MALL COP (PG):

Paul Blart (Kevin James) is a guy who dreams of becoming a New Jersey State Trooper. Until that happens, he is making the best of his current job – security guard at the local mall. He lives with his mother and daughter and dreams of finding that special person who can love and appreciate him for himself. Paul takes his job very seriously and gets his opportunity to prove his mettle when crooks take over the mall on Black Friday to steal millions of dollars in credit codes. What follows is a series of unbelievable stunts involving skateboards, bikes and a Segway scooter.

The language in this film is mild and most of the "violence" is comedic. It sends the message that good guys can still finish first, and even the most unlikely person can be a true hero.
