The New Waverly Public Library is located at 200 Gibbs Street, also the city hall building. A new location is being built and is expected to be open later this year. The phone number is (936) 344-2198, and this is also the fax number so keep trying if no one answers. For more information, the library's Web site is www.newwaverlypubliclibrary.com.

Sunday the library is closed. Monday and Tuesday hours are noon to 4:30. The library is closed on Wednesdays. Thursday hours are from 9:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. Friday and Saturday hours are from noon to 4:30.

Library cards are free to anyone. A person wanting a library card must fill out an application, which can be obtained at the library.

Patrons have free Internet access and can check out media and DVDs. There is a literacy program in the works. There are various children's programs such as after school and summer programs.

Huntsville

The Huntsville Public Library is located on 1216 14th Street and the phone number is 936-291-5472. For more information, the library's Web site is www.myhuntsvillelibrary.com.

Hours are 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday through Thursday and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. The library is closed on Sundays.

Persons 18 or older are able to obtain a library card by giving two forms of identification: picture ID such as a driver's license and proof of physical address.

P.O. boxes are not accepted as addresses. Children under 18 must have a parent sign for them and young children may get a card when they can legibly sign their name. Also, the library accepts the TexShare cards from other libraries. People living anywhere in Texas can use the library with this card.

Services provided by the library include reference assistance, literacy programs, nursing home programs, volunteer opportunities, IRS tax forms and genealogical records.

Books can be renewed online as well as in the library itself. Refer to the Web site for more information.

Sunday hours are 2 p.m. to 1 a.m. Monday through Wednesday hours are 7:30 a.m. to 1 a.m. Thursday hours are 7:30 a.m. to 12 a.m. Friday hours are 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday hours are 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

University students and faculty and staff have full use of library resources. Students must show their BearKat One ID card. People with the TexShare Card may check out resources. People not affiliated with the university, such as

Huntsville residents, may browse library resources but can't borrow any without the Courtesy Card. Applications for Courtesy Cards are at the library circulation desk and there is an annual fee of \$20. The loan period for everyone is two weeks.

The library offers many services such as library tours. University faculty can put books on hold for a particular course, consult with other faculty, order books and journals and other services. If the library doesn't own a book, there is a book request online for the library to purchase that book. Users can renew books online. Also, there is the InterLibrary service where books from other libraries such as Rice University and Texas A&M libraries can be found and reserved.
