CHARITY GAMING

Legalized gambling is not always held on a casino floor. The state tightly regulates charity gaming operations and the millions it brings in for organizations.

In 2005, the following licensed organizations raised more than \$12 million from bingo and pull tabs. After expenses, net proceeds were \$638,763, down from \$1.2 million in 2004. Of that, the groups gave about \$207,000 to charity.

2005 AMOUNTS RAISED BY BINGO/PULL TABS

- **Fraternal Order of Police No. 100, Jeffersonville,** \$3.5 million. After expenses, net proceeds were \$125,277, a 4 percent profit. Of that, the organization gave about \$5,600 to charity. Amount retained, \$119,627.

- **Knights of Columbus No. 1348, Jeffersonville,** \$2.2 million. Net proceeds, \$89,720, a 4 percent profit. About \$88,000 went to charity. Amount retained: \$1,000.

- **Loyal Order of Moose Lodge No. 2420, Jeffersonville,** \$1.4 million. Net proceeds, \$36,228, a 3 percent profit. About \$5,800 went to charity. Amount retained, \$16,000.

- **Southern Indiana Youth Boosters, Inc., Charlestown,** \$2.4 million. Net proceeds, \$105,127, a 4 percent profit. About \$11,000 went to charity. Amount retained, \$47,255.

- **St. Paul Catholic Church, Sellersburg,** \$713,067. Net proceeds, \$18,914, a 12 percent profit. About \$70,000 went to charity. Amount retained, \$0.

- **Tri County Shrine Club, Clarksville,** \$719,000. Net proceeds, \$3,822, a 3 percent profit. About \$6,700 went to charity. Amount retained, \$12,164.

- **VFW Post No. 1427, Charlestown,** \$147,000. Net proceeds, \$3,822, a 3 percent profit. About \$2,000 went to charity. Amount retained, \$150.

2005 AMOUNTS RAISED BY PULL TABS ONLY

- **American Legion Post No. 35, Jeffersonville,** \$334,343. Net proceeds, \$63,494, a 19 percent profit. About \$5,500 went to charity. Amount retained, \$29,718.

- **American Legion Post, No. 335, Charlestown,** \$358,385. Net proceeds, \$51,308, a 14 percent profit. About \$1,200 went to charity. Amount retained, \$50,108.

- **Fraternal Order of Eagles No. 1527, Jeffersonville,** \$135,093. Net proceeds, \$28,590, a 21 percent profit. About \$3,800 went to charity. Amount retained, \$23,547.

- **Loyal Order of Moose Lodge No. 1757, Sellersburg,** \$131,393. Net proceeds, \$29,335, a 22 percent profit. About \$5,500 went to charity. Amount retained, \$18,171.

- **VFW Post No. 1832, Jeffersonville,** \$60,343. Net proceeds, \$1,409, a 2 percent profit. About \$1,400 went to charity. Amount retained, \$0.

BINGO/PULL TABS GROSS AMOUNTS:

- **2005:** \$6.9 million
- **2004:** \$8.9 million
- **2003:** \$9.3 million
- **2002:** \$9.8 million

In 2005, the following licensed organizations raised more than \$6.8 million from bingo and pull tabs. After expenses, net proceeds were \$693,296, down from \$733,405 in 2004. Of that, the groups gave about \$110,000 to charity.

NOTE: Figures do not include amounts undistributed by the organizations.

- **American Legion Post No. 28, New Albany,** \$3.4 million. Net proceeds, \$311,919, a 9 percent profit. About \$34,000 went to charity. Amount retained, \$222,835.

- **BPO Elks Lodge No. 270, New Albany,** \$1.9 million. Net proceeds, \$201,313, a 10 percent profit. About \$20,000 went to charity. Amount retained, \$150,000.

- **Friends of Fairview, Inc., New Albany,** \$485,766. Net proceeds, \$35,801, a 7 percent profit. None went to charity. Amount retained, \$35,801.

- **Knights of Columbus No. 1221, New Albany,** \$230,231. Net proceeds, \$13,477, a 6 percent profit. About \$12,000 went to charity. Amount retained \$472.
