# Looking for a return trip

A good nucleus of players return to the gridiron for the Wynnewood Savages this season as they look to make a return to the Class A playoffs. Wynnewood ran into a buzz saw last year at Rush Springs but a new district and a new direction await the Savages this fall.

Coach Jay Vermillion and the Savages got the season kicked off with a big off season.

"We went to a team camp at Lindsay and participated in a pass-

ing league at Pauls Valley this summer and I feel like it has really helped our team," Vermillion said. "Our numbers are not as good as we would like but we think we will have around 30 kids on our team."

The Savages were dealt a blow on the offensive side of the ball with the loss of Dustin Ervin to college and Terry Sanders to Pauls Valley. That's well over 1,500 yards of offense gone for the Savages but coach Vermillion feels that he

has some quality players to fill the voids.

"We lost Dustin Ervin, a 1,200-yard rusher and two-way starter Richard Baker," Vermillion said. "We only lost five senior but all will be missed. We also lost Terry Sanders who moved to Pauls Valley.

"We feel like we have a majority of our players back, with a lot of players that got a lot of playing time last year. We were very young last year and feel we can improve from last year."

Offensively, the Savages will open things up a little more with the spread offense. Junior quarterback Blake Perry will guide the Savages this season. Perry is capable of either the run or pass depending on the situation. Sophomore running back Charles Heath got some carries last year and should be able to build upon his freshmen experiences.

Up front Paul and Nathan McCurley will anchor the line. P. McCurley (6-2, 275) is a senior while N. McCurley
