Panthers rebuilding

It appears to be a rebuilding year in the Valley after the loss of 14 seniors off last year's squad.

The Panthers have good numbers to start with over 45 kids suiting out for the varsity squad.

"The numbers are about what I thought," head coach Kevin Foster said. "I'll let whatever freshmen suit up that want to, so that will out us up to about 50 or so on Friday nights."

The Pauls Valley Panthers do have some skill positions players returning but the biggest losses came in the trenches where five starters and part-time starters are now pursuing other options.

"We are having to replace a lot of players on both sides of the ball," Foster said. "They are getting better everyday at practice."

Pauls Valley will have to rely on some sophomores up front. Robert

Smith and Coleton Presgrove have emerged and will give this team some up need size.

Chase Hunt provides senior leadership and some experience in the trenches. Hunt a college prospect as a deep snapper will get the call in the middle of the line at center. Joey Colmenares and Chris Colmenares round out the offensive line with several other players including Tyler Brown, Mason Maness, Caden Holt and Randy Ray that will rotate in to keep the line fresh.

With Foster coming in and coach Mike Terry leaving, a position opened for a new offensive coordinator to come in. Richard Norman has brought in a different look to the spread offense and it will be the focal point for the Panthers this season as they look to utilize their speed.

Back for the Panthers is 1,000-

yard rusher Tyler Harding. The junior is already on the Class 3A radar after he was named to the 2008 State Farm Mr. Football Oklahoma Watch List. Harding had over 1,100 yards last year in his sophomore campaign with 13 touchdowns.

Harding is not the only one returning in the backfield. Senior Hank Graham and junior Caleb Livingston shared the lime light last year and it appears they will do the same again this season.

"We will use two QB's until someone emerges as the clear front-runner," coach Foster said.

Both Graham and Livingston are similar but different. Both will bring different talents to the field that can help this team win games.

In the spread look, the Panthers will look to throw the ball a little more that last year. This will help open up the running game for the quarterbacks and Harding.

Seniors Casey Gardner and Adrian Morales return for the Panthers and will be the main targets for Livingston and Graham. Morales led the team with 20 catches last year and even though Gardner didn't make as many catches had some big ones in crunch time.

Several underclassmen will be vying for time on the field at the other wide out positions including Sammy Lopez, Edgar Colmenares, Isaias Lopez and Dillon O'Bryant.

Bo McKee and Tyler Presgrove will had some hands as well as blocking skills when the Panthers need a tight end.
