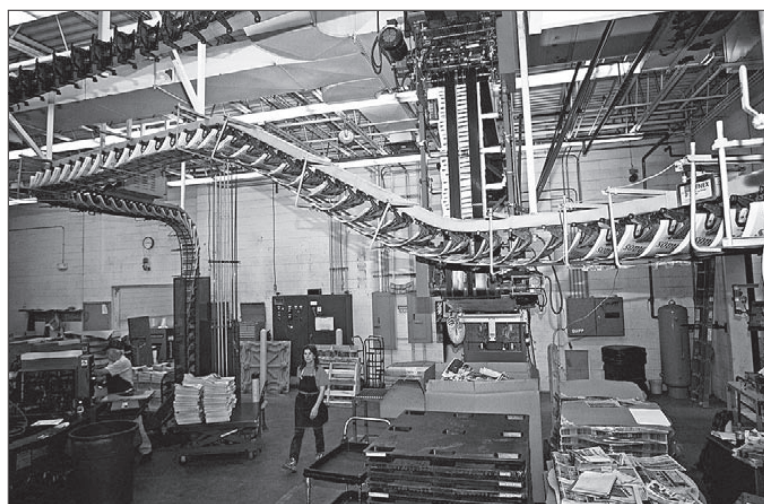
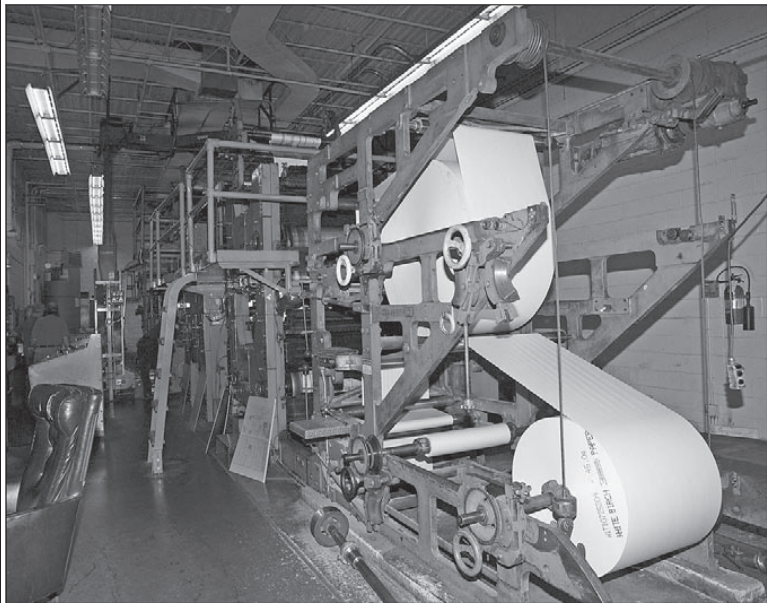


From paper and ink to newspaper

Metal plates with the images of the pages are placed on the press, shown above. The newsprint is fed through the press and the images from the plates are transferred to the newsprint with ink, above center. At the end of the press are the folded newspapers, bottom right. The folded newspapers are put into the inserter machine, seen in the picture at top far right. The inserter machine puts fliers and other items into the newspapers. The conveyor, bottom far right, brings the newspapers to the delivery loading dock for bundling for delivery.
